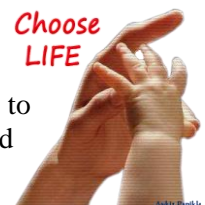
Hamilton Right to Life Baby Bottle Campaign Change for Life Mothers' Day – Fathers' Day

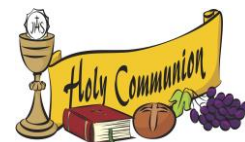
