**"Missionaries of Compassion"** is an Indian borne Clerical Missionary Religious Order, Canonically established in the ArchDiocese of Hyderabad since 2003. The specific purpose of the institute is to carry out the works of Christ’s Compassion by educating the orphans and poor children through our schools and hostels, feeding the hungry poor through our soup kitchens, housing the homeless and caring for the elderly poor and sick through our orphanages, hospices and hospitals. Today the Order has over 250 missionaries (priests and seminarians) working in 18 dioceses in India and 15 outside India which include -Italy, Canada, Tanzania, and five dioceses in the USA. They serve in a total of 36 communities. Besides helping the pastoral works of the needy churches, they run four hospitals (two in India and 2 in Tanzania), 14 schools (12 in India and 2 in Tanzania), providing education to over 15000+ students. Our 5 hospices and retirement houses take care of many elderly poor and sick.

Many of these missions are in the initial stages and need your prayers and financial support. The visit of Rev. Dr. Raju Mathew Panackal, to our Parish this weekend, by invitation of our diocese, is part of our annual participation in the Mission Co-operation to support the works of the Missions by our prayers and financial assistance. Fr. Panackal who holds a PhD., in Canon Law from Rome, was the first Superior General of the Order. After completing his term, presently he is working as the Judicial Vicar of the diocese of Lake Charles in USA and is also the Delegate Superior of the Order in the US and Canada.

There will be envelopes in the pews for your donation to the Missions in support of their work. Your generosity will be greatly appreciated for this noble cause. You can bring your donation next weekend. If you need more information Fr. Panackal will be available after all the Masses of the weekend of June 5-6.
