The specific purpose of the institute is to carry out the works of Christ’s Compassion by educating the orphans and poor children through our schools and hostels, feeding the hungry poor through our soup kitchens, housing the homeless and caring for the elderly poor and sick through our orphanages, hospices and hospitals. Today the Order has over 250 missionaries (priests and seminarians) working in 18 dioceses in India and 15 outside India which include -Italy, Canada, Tanzania, and five dioceses in the USA. They serve in a total of 36 communities. Besides helping the pastoral works of the needy churches, they run four hospitals (two in India and 2 in Tanzania), 14 schools (12 in India and 2 in Tanzania), providing education to over 15000+ students. Our 5 hospices and retirement houses take care of many elderly poor and sick.
